Announcement Alfred Vogt-Scholarship 2025

The Alfred Vogt-Foundation awards scholarships for the promotion of young academics.

Eligible for the scholarship application are young academics who wish to devote themselves intensively and exclusively to scientific research in the field of ophthalmology for a certain period.

The grants are intended for scientists who are Swiss citizens or foreign nationals resident in Switzerland, who are between their dissertation and habilitation and who are aiming for a habilitation.

The grant of an Alfred Vogt-Scholarship is intended to recognise a particularly good, well-developed research project. Purely clinical stays abroad cannot be considered for the scholarship.

Applications must be submitted in English no later than **16 February 2025** on the website of the Alfred Vogt-Foundation (www.alfred-vogt-stiftung.ch) using the online form.

Applications will be evaluated by the Board of Trustees of the Alfred Vogt-Foundation in the same way as applications for the Alfred Vogt-Prize. There is no legal recourse against the decision of the Board of Trustees.
